 - Activity Fee: All students must submit form at \$10 to Jeanie
 - o Please register on Family ID ASAP, so adults have emergency contact information

- Payment and documentation due today for those attending
- o Can accommodate 45 students; PTHS is usually largest student group
- Tomorrow (9/14): will open available spots to Sophomores with most points,
 Jeanie Cygrymus will send invitations
- Juniors/Seniors will perform One Act; auditions Oct. 17, 6:30 pm
- o Sophomores invited will not perform but will help with thespies and tech
- Prep begins when fall play ends
- Scholarships will be given at conference; students that plan to major or minor in theater and/or music will be eligible to audition for scholarships; interested should tell Mrs. Cygrymus as soon as possible
- November 30-Dec 3-Conference
 - Note: begins on Thursday; students have permission for early dismissal
- November 29, 7 pm: Preview night for parents
- Board reported that for 2022 (and in past years), Backers helped with funding to conference, by providing \$3000 to cover bus expense. Averages \$67 benefit to students whose parents are Backers.
 - Motion to provide \$3000 to Conference made by Jill Clydesdale; 2nd by Julie Collins. Motion passed.
- Auditions: approaching quickly for coffeehouse, musical, and conference

- Mrs. Gizzi and Mrs. Cygrymus will hold workshop prior to musical auditions (date TBD)
 - Overview of audition format, how-to's; no specific information about upcoming auditions; meant to inform those new to high school auditions
- Improv Class: to be held by Mrs. Cygrymus, date and location TBA (updates on Band app)
- Play Reading Committee: to be formed, students will read and discuss a variety of plays and give input regarding number of students needed, types of roles available, etc.
 Students who volunteer will receive points. See Mrs. Cygrymus for details.
- Field Trip: Dinner and Show-Mamma Mia
 - o 3/27, 72 tickets are available; sign up online (date of sign ups TBA)
 - Students from all grades are invited to sign up for a ticket
 - Discount given by Backers to those students whose parents are members
 - 2022 Field Trip-Backers gave \$30/student discount
 - 2023 Field Trip to be slightly more expensive due to cost of show
 - Discussion held regarding costs and opportunity to offer larger student discount of \$40/student. Cost per student (bus, show, dinner) is \$120.
 Students will make \$80 deposit. If \$40 discount given, no more will be owed for Backers' children.
 - Motion made by Joanne Gudenburr to give \$40 discount/student (Backers' members)
 - 2nd made by Jill Clydesdale
 - Motion passed to give \$40 discount per student attending show, if student's parent is a member of Backers.

- Fall Play-Directed by Mr. Cygrymus
 - Parent meeting was held Sept 11 with play information; will be provided by email to those who could not attend
 - o Mr. Cygrymus reported that cast and crew are progressing well
 - All thespians are encouraged to see the play and sign in for points
 - September 15-Tickets on sale online, assigned seating
 - September 8-Fall play merchandise orders due
 - Donations accepted for props; see Mrs. Cygrymus
- Spirit Wear Sale: New for this year, allows recognition of our program (especially during conference and other events). Form available on the Band app
 - Funds applied to each grade separately for their future Senior Trip (more details below)

 - Expenses included gift card for photographer for program headshots
 - Requested motion to approve budget: Amy Berner; 2nd by Julie Collins
- Fundraisers
 - Fall Fundraiser is "Set the stage for fall"
 - Prize is Traeger Pro 780 Grill (value approx. \$1000), 7 piece All Clad set (donated by Taylors, approx. value \$500). Additional items provided by Ace Hardware including grill cover, sauces, rubs, etc. Ace will also deliver and set up if winner within 5 mile radius of the store.
 - Tickets are \$20 each, each family asked to sell 10 tickets to support Troupe. Students were instructed to pick up tickets and instructions at student meeting; Kristen has tickets and instructions for anyone in need
 - Return tickets and money prior to drawing at Oct 15 show. Can give to Kristianna, Kristen or any other board member. Payments can be made by cash, check, or Venmo

- Donut Sales-reduced from 3 to 2 sales this year (11/18 and 2/10)
 - Link is live on our site for ordering; price increased to \$10 per dozen this year, to help with donut cost increase (\$7.50) and ease of collection
 - All students must attend at least 1 sale in person

- Must also sell 5 dozen donuts
- Sell 10 dozen if unable to attend either sale
- Student meeting: discussed way to make it easier to meet goals.
 Students suggested splitting into 10 groups and each group sells
 33 dozen so that all are presold
