 - Performces are typically music (bands, groups, instrumental), monologues, poetry, dance, etc.
 - o Theme: Mojo Dojo Coffeehouse '23: Barbie edition
 - o 10/24/23: Auditions in 10 minute slots, 2:30-6:30
 - Must provide copy of any written material to be performed (e.g. lyrics, poem, monologue) to Beth Wilmus for approval
 - 10/26/23: Show host auditions
 - *10/27/23: Tentative date for posting of casted acts*
 - o 10/31/23: Performers meeting
 - o TBD: Rehearsal schedule and parents' meeting
 - Direct questions to Beth
 - Jeanie Cygrymus adds information
 - New Band app will be added after show is casted
 - Show needs variety for audience interest and entertainment; cuts are made to avoid redundancy. Example: no 2 acts can perform same song.
 Encourage students to be creative. Ideally, every act will be in 2/3 shows
- Activity Fee: Must be paid prior to participation in any thespian activities (fall play, meetings, parties, field trips, etc); check with Jeanie if you are unsure if you have paid
- Play Reading Committee

 - o Fall Fundraiser is "Set the stage for fall"
 - Prize is Traeger Pro 780 Grill (value approx. \$1000), 7 piece All Clad set (donated by Taylors, approx. value \$500). Additional items provided by Ace Hardware including grill cover, sauces, rubs, etc. Ace will also deliver and set up if winner within 5 mile radius of the store.
 - Tickets are \$20 each, each family asked to sell 10 tickets to support
 Troupe. Turn in money and stubs by Friday
 - Donut Sales-first is Oct 28
 - All students must participate in fundraising as a PA Thespian rule
 - Volunteer at sale + sell 5 boxes OR Sell 10 boxes if unable to attend; students are asked to attend at least 1 sale
 - Ask customers to note student's name on order
 - If unsure of how many sold, see Mandy Feitt
 - In need of students and drivers (drivers cannot be students)
 - 325 dozen need to be sold, can order more if needed
 - Krispy Kreme sells to us for \$7.50/box and we sell for \$10/box. They suggest \$15/box (store price) but board and Backers feel \$10 is easier to sell.
