#### Kristianna Gizzi:

- Expenses: reminder that many occur in Nov/Dec
  - o Expense to consider is additional tech director for musical, not covered by school
    - Must be voted on and renewed each year (according to by-laws)
- Mamma Mia
  - 2-hour workshop to be held at PTHS on 3/27 (day of show) in AM
  - Permission given by school administration for students to miss class to attend
  - Additional information to follow once cost and actors confirmed
  - Children of Backers will not be charged to attend
- Musical-All Shook Up
  - o 3/14 and 3/15 at 7 pm; 3/16 matinee at 2 pm
  - Cast party-2 parents have volunteered to help; to be held after final show (3/16) in cafeteria
    - Extra funds from merchandise and concessions will be used; if no available funds, will charge students (in past, cost has been \$5/student)
    - Includes dinner, cake and senior speeches
  - Senior Rec: held opening night of Musical
    - Recognition is for all Senior Thespians, not just those in musical
    - Lockers decorated; yards decorated night before musical
  - Stage Crew: new addition to this year's musical
    - First set build is this Saturday (1/13)
    - Sign up on band app to volunteer (no mandatory tech build this year)
  - Applause Ads: new this year, additional fundraising effort

- Opportunity for students/family/friends to recognize cast and crew
- Use QR code (form provided), cost is \$20 (check or Venmo), must make payment before submitting ad, max 20 words
- Review student policies in Band app; reminder to enroll in Family ID to participate
- o 2/12/24, 8 am: Ticket sales begin online
- Teasers: usually 1-2 songs, chosen by directors, to increase ticket sales
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade Move Up Day, The Waters, and PTHS AM announcements
- o Props: Cari Williams will collect; will post list of needed items in band app
- o Gifts: Student thespian leaders will collect for directing staff
- Schedule: Please follow band app for updates
  - Directors make every effort to be mindful of students needed for each rehearsal and will only call necessary cast
  - Students should assume they will be needed for every rehearsal beginning 3/1 but check app to verify
  - Changes will happen based on progress (e.g. choreography may need additional time, vocals may be ahead of schedule)
- Senior Trip
  - Names of actors for workshops will be provided soon and their bios will be posted in band app
  - All money for trip was fundraised by seniors and paid by their families; with exception of lunches, Backers funds not used
- Thespian Backers Board
  - o All positions are available for next year
  - Please see Kristianna with any questions about responsibilities and time commitment

  - o Encouraged families to support, as many thespians are also in music

  - Note to families of Juniors: consider joining this year as students are ONLY eligible for Senior Scholarship if family has been a member of Backers for at least 2 years (i.e., join in Senior year, ineligible for Scholarship)

- Musical Concessions
  - Change in process for this year. Previously, parents used Sign Up Genius to choose items to purchase and donate. With rising costs, this became inequitable between families (i.e. cost of water vs candy).
  - o Julie Collins: gave information on new donation process
    - Each family (cast + crew) to donate \$25 concession fee
    - Julie will collect and purchase items; keeping spreadsheet of items purchased/used
    - Pay Julie via Venmo or Check made payable to "Cash"
